

## How do I customize the Panel Layout and Frames?

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By default the panel frames are 5 Columns by 5 Rows, with a white border and black shadow.

However, you can customize the grid and frames on all panel pages.

### Panel Layout

To customize your Grid and Frames, open the **Advanced** tab on the Panel hover and choose **Grid**.

Start by deciding how many **Columns** and **Rows** you would like on the page then change the number in both fields.

Enter a number 1 in the **Features** field to make the first image on the page larger than the rest. The Features field begins in the top left and works its way across the portraits, so you can have as many Featured Images as you like.

The default for the **Automatic** field for **Knockouts** is to turned off.

If you are going to add Images or ClipArt and do not want it to cover the portraits, but the portraits to move around the new image or clipart, you will want to place a check mark in the **Automatic** field.

Under the Layout section, you have the Frames and Last Row fields. Both the fields are to adjust the position of the entire group of frames on the page.

Use the **Frames** field, to align the entire group of portraits with any of the options; such as Gutter or Center.

Use the **Last Row** field to align the last row of portraits with any of the options, such as Center.

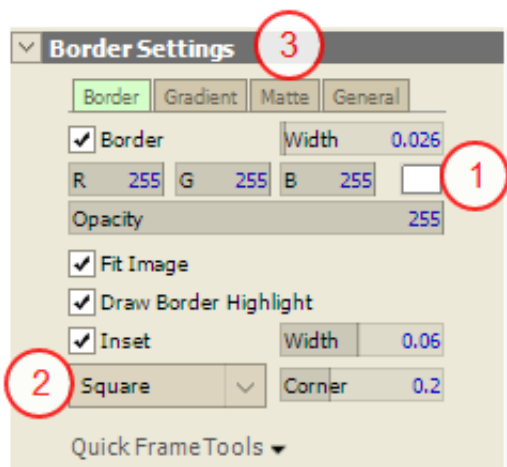
The **Top**, **Bottom**, **Gutter** and **Edge** sliders can be used to increase or decrease the amount of space between the group of portraits and the specified section of the page.

## Panel Frames

On the Panel hover, under the **Border Settings** section are the same same options that you would see on the Frame Editor.

Below are some explains of the changes you can make and anything you do will apply to all the portraits:

1. Change the Border Color
2. Change the Shape
3. Apply a Gradient or Matte

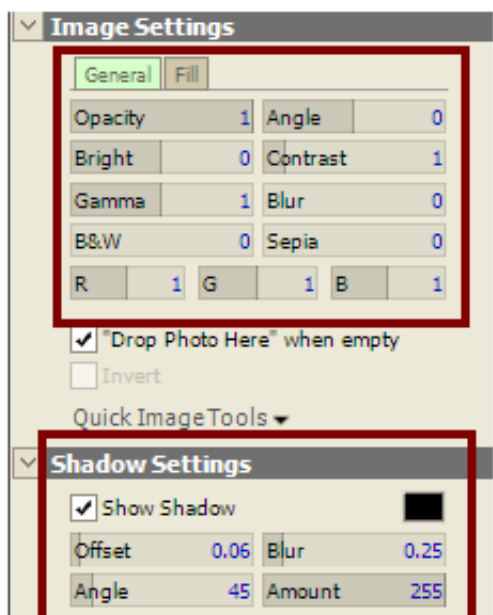


On the Panel hover, under the **Image Settings** section are the same same options that you would see on the Image Editor

- Can make images black and white
- Adjust the image contrast

Under the **Shadow Settings** section are the same same options that you would see on the Shadow Editor.

- Can turn the image shadow off
- Change the color of the shadow
- Change the position



*Note: when customizing, be sure your panel is scoped correctly. At the top of the Panel hover, you can choose to apply changes to All panels, a set of groups within your panels, or a single group. Ensure that you've chosen the correct option for the change you are trying to make – eg: don't choose All panels or All groups within a panel set if you want the settings you are going to apply to be specific to a certain class.*
