

Where can I find templates?


YearbookFusion provides free access to a large collection of pre-made layouts. Templates provide an efficient way to quickly build a beautiful yearbook. All templates are completely editable, so you can change backgrounds, frame arrangements, fonts, and any other aspect of the design to make them custom to your needs.

Templates can be added to your project in two ways.

Adding Templates from My Book tab


To add templates to your ladder, click on the Add Pages button, then choose Templates.





Three categories of templates will be displayed, with the option to look at the templates as single or double page spreads.






Click down to the category of your choice until you find a template you would like to include in your book.

Hover over the template and click the + sign to add it to the book, or drag it to the book ladder to the location you want to use it.






Adding Templates directly to a page


Templates can also be added directly pages in your book. Open a section of your book on the ladder. On the Editor tab, click on the Template button to access the collection.






When you locate a template you would like to use, you can drag it directly to your page. If you are using a double-page spread, drag it to either the left or the right side of the page to apply it to a single side. Alternatively, hover over the template to apply the template (to the left or right side) or insert it as a new page to your section.





You can add two different templates to each side of a double-spread, or the same template twice. You can replace the template with another choice - just redrop - even if you have photos in the template. They will move to the new layout.





Template types and categories

There is no downloadable pdf catalogue for the template collection as new material and updates are occurring throughout the year.

The following is an overview of the categories of the current collections.

Basic Templates

Divided into categories based on the number of empty frames on the page, you will find a collection of plain arrangements with simple empty frames and text placeholders. Like all templates, these are completely editable, so you can customise them with background papers, photos, text and fonts.



Complete Yearbooks

This category contains "designer" collections, suitable for a wide range of ages and tastes.

Each theme collection contains 40 or more coordinating templates.



Themed pages

Here is where you will find school-related pages. These reflect occasions where schools may organize specific events, clubs and teams, and other common yearbook theme pages.

- Arts & Performance: Cinema, Circus & magic, Dance, Music, Theatre, Visual arts, and Talent show.
- Holidays & Celebrations: Black history month, Christmas, Earth Day, Easter, Halloween, Memorial & Remembrance, Mother's & Father's Day, St. Patricks, Thanksgiving,



Valentines.

- Media & Journalism: AV & Computers, Journalism & Photography.
- School Themes: Cafeteria & Nutrition, Elections & Committees, Fundraising events, Games club, Graduation, Home Ec & Shop, Library & Literature, Math & Science, Social Studies.
- Seasons: Fall, Spring, Summer, Winter
- **Sports:** Athletics general, Baseball & softball, Basketball, Cheer, Football, Golf, Gymnastics, Soccer, Tennis, Track and Field, Volleyball, Wrestling, and general team layouts.
- Yearbook: Baby pics, Back to school, Faves, Graduate Class grids, Principal welcome, Senior ads, and Superlatives.
